ALSO NEEDED:

- Fine Sandpaper
- Wood Glue
- Hammer
- #2 Phillips Screwdriver

Assembly:

Start with sanding each wood piece to remove any rough edges. Remember to sand in the direction of the wood grain. Glue and nail the pieces together. Allow glue to completely dry.

Step 1—Stand both **side pieces** on the long edges. Make sure the slots are close to the bottom edges and facing in.

Step 2—Add thin lines of glue to the top edges. Place the **bottom piece** on top. Make sure outside edges are even. Carefully, nail them together with 6 nails.

Step 3—Stand the project on the back edge. Avoiding the slots, add little glue to the top edge of the **side pieces**. Place the **front piece** on top with the opening at the bottom edge. Nail it in place with 2 nails.

Step 4—Lay the **game board** flat. Align the holes, carefully add the **game board sticker**. Lay the **back piece** flat. Add the **back sticker** to the top edge so that the **sticker** is not covering the screw holes. Put the **game board** and **back piece** aside until the final step.

Attention: If you are painting the project, paint only the bottom assembly and game pieces. Make sure not to paint the slots in the side pieces. Painting the slots will make it difficult to slide the **game board** in! Allow the paint to dry completely.

Step 5—Slide the **game board** into the slots. Match the screw holes in the **back piece** and **side pieces**. Using a #2 Phillips Screwdriver, attach them together with 4 screws.
