


WARNING: CHOKING HAZARD—Small Parts.

Not for children under 3 years.


The product contains functional sharp points and sharp edge. Not for children under 4 years. Adult supervision required.






Assembly:

Start with sanding each wood piece to remove any rough edges. Remember to sand in the direction of the wood grain. Glue and nail the pieces together. Allow glue to completely dry.






Step 2—Lay the **gondola** down with the nail holes facing up. The edge with the cutout is the front edge. Lay the airship piece with the tab down. Slide the tab into the cutout in the gondola. Make sure edges are even. Using 2 short nails, nail them together.



Step 3—Lay both **engines** down with the nail holes facing up. Start 4 medium nails.



Step 4—Glue one of the **engines** on the **gondola** with top and back edges even. Make sure the screw hole is on the back edge. Carefully, nail it in place. Turn the project over and repeat to attach the other engine.

Attention: If you are painting the project, DO NOT paint round the screw holes on the back of the engines. Allow paint to dry completely.



Step 6—Using a #2 Phillips Screwdriver, add the propellers to the engines with 2 screws. Don't screw too tightly and make sure **propellers** spin. Add the **stickers** as shown.
