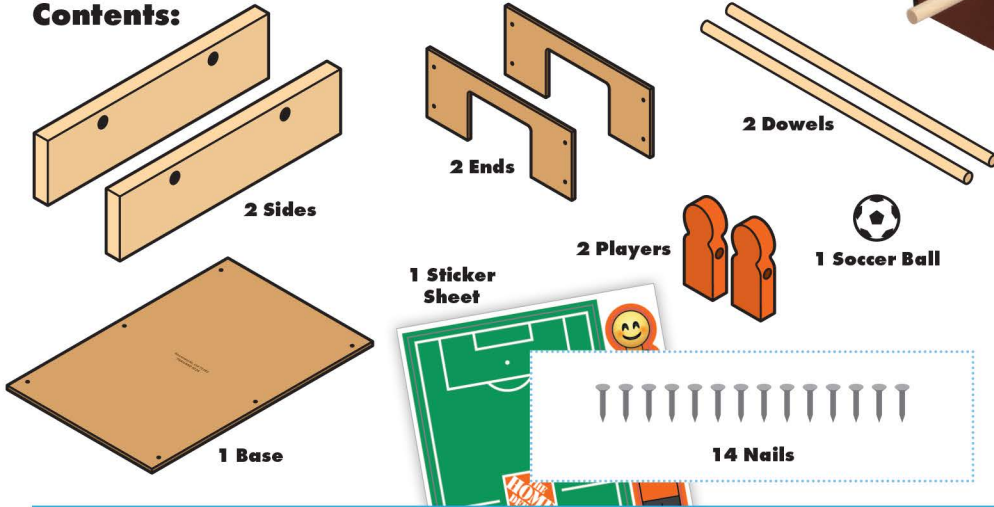

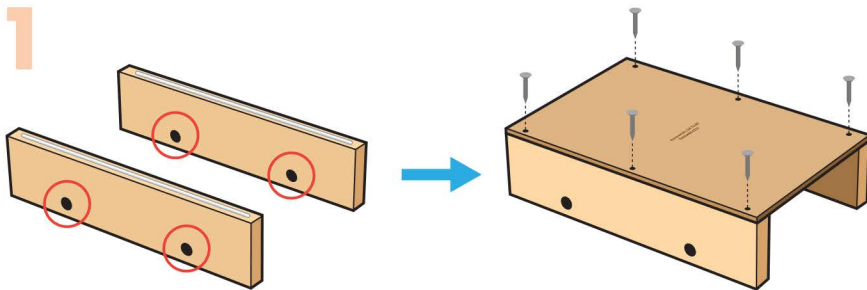

ALSO NEEDED:

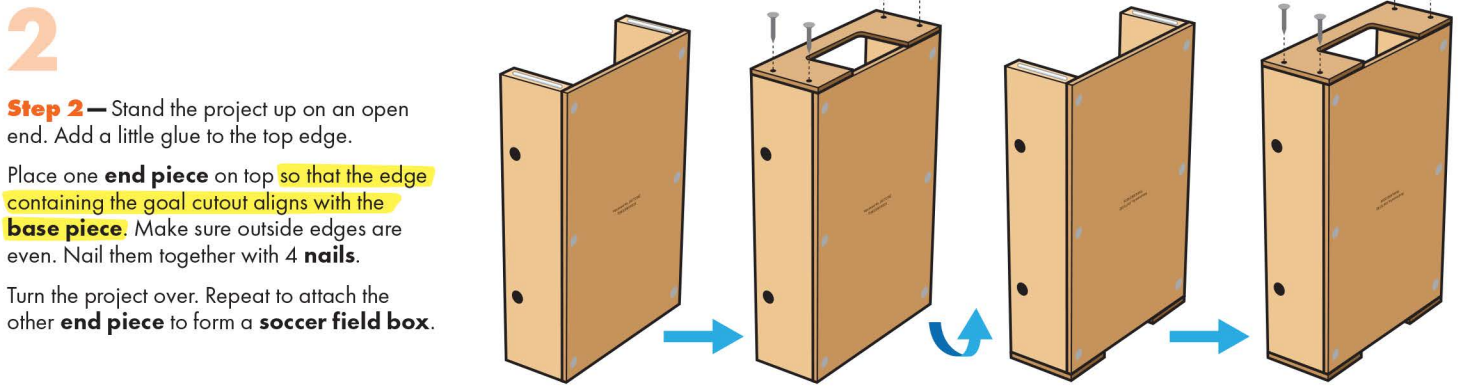
- Fine Sandpaper
- Wood Glue
- Hammer

Assembly:

Start with sanding each wood piece to remove any rough edges. Remember to sand in the direction of the wood grain. Glue and nail the pieces together. Allow glue to completely dry.

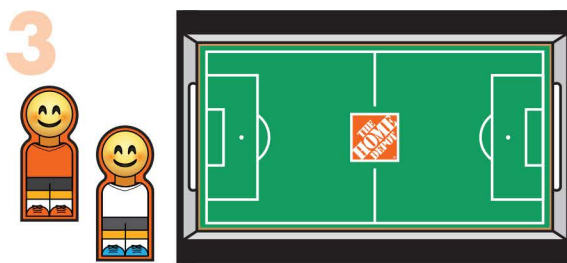


Step 1 — Stand both side pieces on long edges with dowel holes close to the bottom. Add thin lines of glue to the top edges. Place the base piece on top. Make sure outside edges are even. Nail them together with 6 nails.

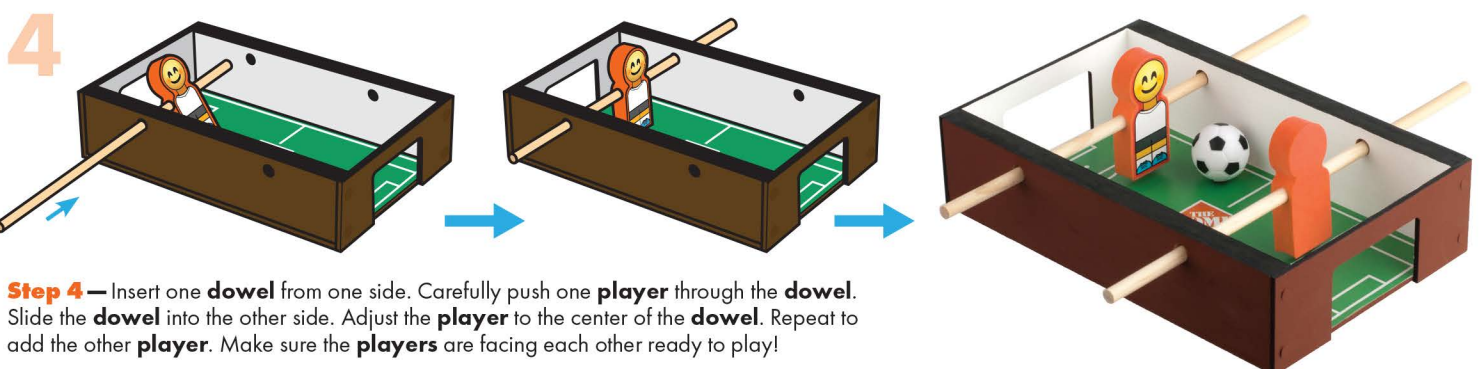


Step 2 — Stand the project up on an open end. Add a little glue to the top edge. Place one end piece on top so that the edge containing the goal cutout aligns with the base piece. Make sure outside edges are even. Nail them together with 4 nails. Turn the project over. Repeat to attach the other end piece to form a soccer field box.

Attention: If you are painting the project, paint only the soccer field box. Try not to put any paint inside the dowel holes. Also, don't paint the dowels or players. Let the paint dry completely before moving on to next step.



Step 3 — Add the stickers to the players and inside the soccer field box.



Step 4 — Insert one dowel from one side. Carefully push one player through the dowel. Slide the dowel into the other side. Adjust the player to the center of the dowel. Repeat to add the other player. Make sure the players are facing each other ready to play!
