



- Fine Sandpaper
- · Wood Glue
- Hammer


Assembly:


Start with sanding each wood piece to remove any rough edges. Remember to sand in the direction of the wood grain. Glue and nail the pieces together. Allow glue to completely dry.



Step 1—Lay a **blade** flat. Push the tab into the cutout in a **handle**. Make sure side edges are even and the **blade** is inserted all the way. Nail them together using 2 **short nails** to make a **paddle**. Repeat to make another **paddle**.

Step 2—Lay the net flat. Lay the posts down with the nail holes facing up. Push the ends of the net into the cutouts in the posts. Make sure top and bottom edges are even and the net is inserted all the way. Nail them together using 4 short nails.





Step 3—Stand the project up. Add a dot of glue to the top edge of each **post**. Pick up a **base** with the cutout side facing down. Fit the cutout onto one of the **posts** with the nail hole close to the outer edge. Make sure side edges are even. Nail it in place using a **long nail**. Repeat to attach the other **base**.

Attention: If you are painting the project, paint and wait to dry completely before adding the **stickers**.



Step 4—Add the sticker to each side of the net.
