- #2 Phillips Screwdriver


Assembly:

Start with sanding each wood piece to remove any rough edges. Remember to sand in the direction of the wood grain. Glue and nail the pieces together. Allow glue to completely dry.





Stand one **divider** up with screw hole facing up. Add a little glue to the top edge.




Step 2—Pick up the bottom piece. The 2 big holes in the center are for screws. Align the screw holes in the bottom piece and divider. Attach them together with a screw using a #2 Phillips Screwdriver. Repeat to attach the other divider.







Step 3—Stand one **side piece** up on a shorter edge. Add a little glue to the top edge.



Step 4—Place one end of the project on top. Make sure outside edges are even. Nail them together with a **nail**. Repeat to attach the other **side piece**.




Step 5—Turn the project on an open end. Add a little glue to the top edge of the **side pieces** and **dividers**.



Step 6—
Pick up one pencil shape. Using the aiming lines as guide, place the pencil shape on top. Make sure bottom edges are even. Nail it in place with 4 nails. Turn the project over and repeat to attach the other pencil shape.

Attention: If you are painting the project, paint and let dry completely before adding the stickers.
