



- Fine Sandpaper
- · Wood Glue
- Hammer
- #2 Phillips Screwdriver

Assembly:

Start with sanding each wood piece to remove any rough edges. Remember to sand in the direction of the wood grain. Glue and nail the pieces together. Allow glue to completely dry.



Step 1 — Stand both **side pieces** up.


Glue one **horizontal panel** on top. Make sure all four corners are even. Nail them together with 2 **long nails**.

Turn the **project** over and repeat to attach the other **horizontal panel**.


Step 2 — Lay the back piece flat with the printed words facing down.


Place the **project** on top. Important: Ensure the screw hole on the right side piece is facing up.

Hold the **project** and **back piece** together, then carefully turn them over. Align the bottom corners and secure them with four **short nails**.



Painting Tip: If painting the project, avoid clogging the screw hole. Let the paint dry completely before moving to the next step.





Step 4 — Carefully peel off the **house sticker** from its backing. Align it with the shapes of the **front piece**. Ensure the hole lines up with the **screw**. Apply the other **stickers** as desired.

At Home: Fill the **Haunted Candy Box** with individually wrapped candies.
