




Assembly:

1 End

Start by sanding each wood piece to smooth any rough edges, following the grain. Glue is optional for added security. Let it dry completely.

Cutout (for handle)



Step 1 — Identify the **side pieces**, the **end piece**, and the **end piece with the cutout**. All four pieces have a vertical slot in the middle. Each **side piece** has a horizontal slot close to the bottom edge. Each **end piece** has a horizontal guide line close to the bottom edge.


Fine Sandpaper


Wood Glue (optional)





Stand both **end pieces** up on the long edges, with the slots facing inward and the guide lines facing each other. Place a **side piece** on top with the slot side down, aligning its horizontal slot with the guide lines on the **end pieces**. Make sure all corners are even. Nail them together.




Step 3 — Stand the **project** upright.







Step 6 — Lay the **project** open side up. Slide the **bottom piece** into the cutouts and the slot.



Step 7 — Fit the remaining side piece on top. Make sure the horizontal slot fits on the bottom piece and the vertical slot fits on the insert. Make sure all corners are even. Nail them together.



Painting Tip: If painting the **project**, paint it and let it dry completely before applying the **stickers** as shown above.
