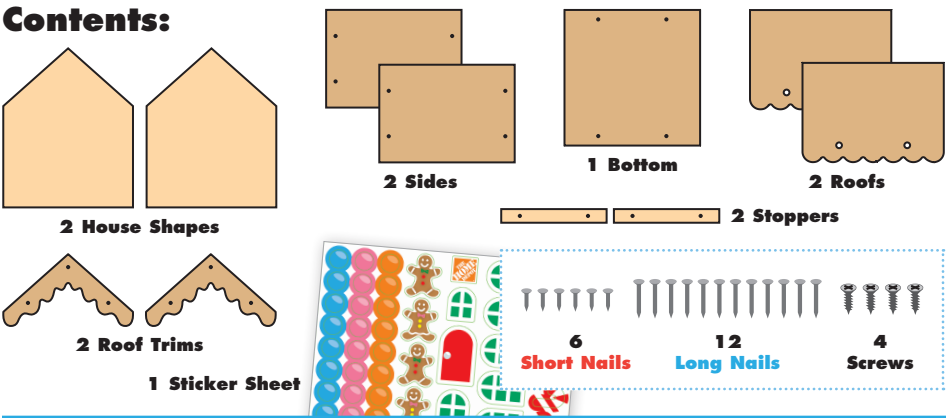

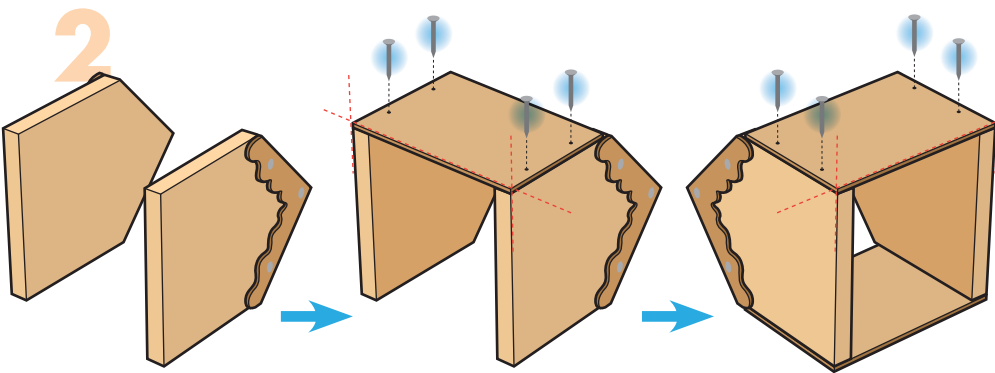
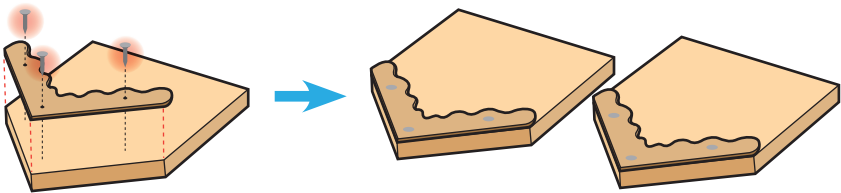


## ALSO NEEDED:

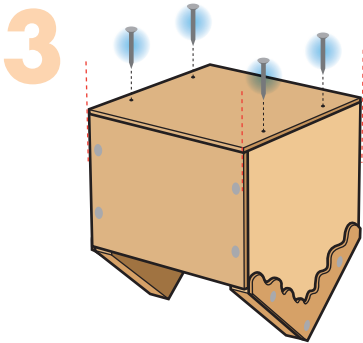
- Safety Goggles
- Fine Sandpaper
- Wood Glue
- Hammer
- Phillips Head Screwdriver

**Assembly:** Start with sanding each wood piece to remove any rough edges. Remember to sand in the direction of the wood grain. Glue and nail the pieces together. Allow glue to completely dry.

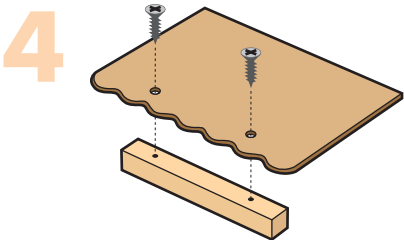
**1 Step 1** — Lay one house shape piece down. Place one roof trim on the pointed edge. Make sure top and side edges are even. Using 3 short nails, nail it in place. Repeat with the other house shape piece.



**Step 2** — Stand both house shape pieces on one side with the roof trims facing out. Glue one side piece on side edges. Make sure side and bottom edges are even. Using 4 long nails, nail it in place. Turn the project over. Repeat to glue and nail the other side piece to this side.



**Step 3** — Turn the project upside down. Glue the bottom piece on bottom edge. Make sure all edges are even. Using 4 long nails, carefully nail it in place to form a house.



**Step 4** — Lay one stopper piece down with the holes on top. Place one roof piece on top and match the holes on both pieces. Using 2 screws, attach them together. Repeat with the other roof piece.

**Attention:** If you are painting the project, paint ONLY the outside. Do not paint the inside. Allow the paint to dry completely before adding the stickers.

**5 Step 5** — Place both roof pieces on the house. Add the stickers.
