CONNECT.


Imagine it's Sunday evening and a huge snowstorm is forecast overnight. More than a foot of snow is supposed to fall!

How do you feel before you go to bed? What are you wishing for?

INVESTIGATE.

Snow days—and snow in general—can be magical. With a layer of snow, the world looks like a different place!

What are some of the adjectives (or descriptive words) that you would use to describe snow? What are some emotions that snow makes you feel? Record your words in the shape here and create a snowflake-shape poem!



- decorate the clear plastic sheet too much, it will be hard to see the scene inside!
- Then, decide where your Snow Globe could use some glitter.
 It could look extra festive with glitter along all of the edges!
 Or perhaps you'd like a little bit almost everywhere! Use the paintbrush to apply the glue in a thin layer and then sprinkle glitter on top.
- 3. Next, think about whether you'd like to add any snow to the outside of the globe so it looks like even more like a winter wonderland. Continue using the paintbrush to add glue and then sprinkle on the artificial snow.
- 4. Lastly, add your LED lights. Nothing says winter coziness like some holiday lights! Try to add them by simply wrapping them around the Snow Globe. If this doesn't work, secure them with the hot glue gun and the help of an adult.
- 5. Finally, step back and take a look at what you've created. It should remind you of the words you wrote in your Snowflake Poem!
