CONNECT.

INNOVATE.

You'll need:

- Your Haunted Candy Box
- Acrylic paint & paint brush
- Glitter
- Glue stick
- Glow-in-the-dark hot glue and hot glue gun
- Glue-in-the-dark stars
- First, pick some of your creepy ideas to paint on your Haunted Candy Box! Could you add a spider or two, for example? Carefully paint your designs on all sides of your Haunted Candy Box, and then wait for the paint to dry.
- Next, think about how you could use the glow-in-the-dark hot glue to make your Haunted Candy Box even spookier. How about a glowing spider web? With an adult's help, use the hot glue gun to bring your ideas to life. Don't forget to let the glue dry before you move on!

- Add some glow-in-the-dark stars around the roof of your Haunted Candy Box. After all, most spooky nights begin with the glow of the Moon and stars!
- Finally, add glitter wherever you think your Haunted Candy Box could use a little extra sparkle. You might want to sprinkle some around the edges, on the spider webs, or even inside the box to give it an extra magical touch.
- Once you're happy with the final design, allow everything to dry completely before filling it with your favorite treats or using it to trick-or-treat. Happy Halloween!
